Thanks to its complimentary root system and the lentils in the mixture

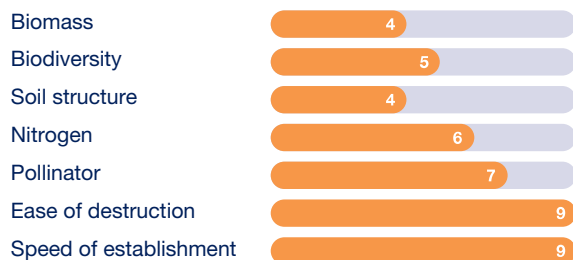

MIXTURE DETAILS

Species	Variety / Type	% Weight	No. kernels/ m ² at min density	Frost sensitivity at maturity	Benefits
Lentil	LENS NIGRICANS (M. BIEB.) WEBB & BERTHEL	35%	25	-7 °C	Slower compared to other legumes. Interesting in association with OSR or for its spring productivity in long cover crops
Berseem Clover	TRIFOLIUM ALEXANDRINUM	15%	77	-7 °C	"Summer" annual clover, sensitive to frost. Best performances for early summer sowing.
Fenugreek	TRIGONELLA FOENUM- GRAECUM	50%	49	-5 °C	Summer legumes,usefull associated to oil seed rape to confuse flea beetle

MIXTURE EFFECTS



1-3 sensitive – poor | 4-6 medium – good | 7-9 tolerant – excellent

SOWING & CULTIVATION

Sowing period	Early August-Late September	It is mixed with the rapeseed and sown together. Cover crops are mostly destroyed by the frost in winter.
Sowing rate	15 kg/ha	
Sowing depth	1-2 cm	
Duration	Annual
