• GRAIN USE MIXTURE

The varieties in the mixture allow harvesting for grain fodder

• A COMPLETE FODDER

It is balanced enough for direct use as rolled or ground. It will supplement well the basic ratio.

• EXCELENT IN ROTATION

After the harvest a summer mixture can be sown to complete the fodder stock, for example MAS NUTRI SORGO VIGNA

Species	Variety / Type	% Weight	No. kernels/ m ² at min density	Frost sensitivity at maturity	Benefits
Field Pea	ASTEROID	20%	18	-10 °C	'Protein type' pea with long vines with high forage yield. Very tolerant to lodging and foliar diseases. Very performant associated with cereals.
Tick Bean	CHIARO DI TORRELAMA	10%	10	-8 °C	Very productive fava bean with TKW around 450g. Very good in mixtures
Triticale	BIKINI	40%	117	-15 °C	High yield potential and methane production. Brings earliness
Soft Wheat	PAJERO	22%	68	-15 °C	Ideotype of forage wheat, healthy, big canopy, tolerant to lodging. Best choices to maximize yield for late spring harvest.
Common Vetch	VICIA SAT WINTER	8%	18	-12 °C	Versatile legumes, fit for all soil and conditions, cover well the soil. Needs a tutor to avoid disease development

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SOWING & CULTIVATION

Sowing period	Late October	Harvest like cereal at correct maturity stage in July. It can be added as a fodder supplement to the diet.
Sowing rate	140 kg/ha	
Sowing depth	2 cm	
Duration	Annual
